Stefanie Reese is Full Professor at RWTH Aachen University and Director of the Institute of Applied Mechanics (IFAM) in Aachen, Germany, which she established in 2010. After receiving her Dr.-Ing. degree in 1994 from the Technische Universität Darmstadt and postdoc stays at the University of California at Berkeley (USA) and the University of Capetown (South Africa) she became in the year 2000 Professor at the Ruhr University Bochum. From 2005 until 2009 she was Full Professor (W3) at the Technische Universität Carolo-Wilhelmina at Braunschweig. She has received several prizes and is member of three academies, among these the National Academy of Science and Engineering. Since 2010, she is Fellow of the International Association for Computational Mechanics (IACM). She is Associate Editor of the open access journal Advanced Modeling and Simulation of Engineering Sciences and holds membership in three editorial boards, e.g. in Computer Methods in Applied Mechanics and Engineering. In 2015, she became Treasurer of the European Mechanics Society (Euromech).
