Recycling

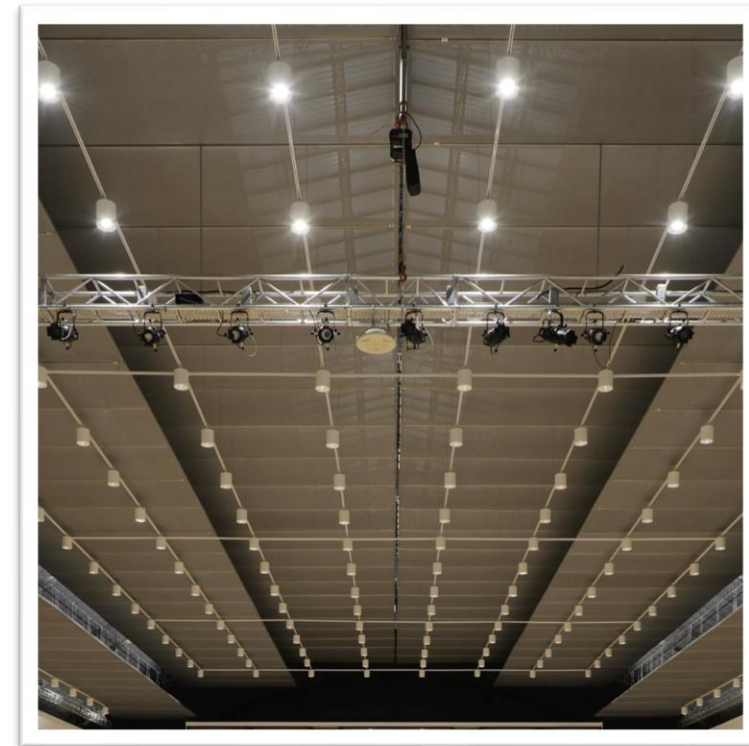
- Milan among Italian cities has always been at the forefront of separate waste
- Waste collection is carried out by **AMSA**, a company belonging to the local municipality see: www.amsa.it/en
- Recently we have built a **new recycling area** designed in collaboration with AMSA with the **aim of further improving the share of differentiation of fractions**
- The area is equipped with inspectable tanks for the collection of liquids with filters to prevent the dumping of polluting substances into the sewer
- We are **currently organizing the service with the suppliers involved**. Fully operational by next spring



Relamping



- **The process of converting all MiCo lighting into LED and / or low-consumption neon lamps started 2 years ago and today is about 90%**
- The process is expected to be completed within the next 12 months
- The lights are all connected to a web based remote control system (through DALI technology)



Healthy Venue



- In 2018 MiCo has been awarded as **Healthy Venue** with the “Silver certification” by the **World Obesity Federation** and is now committed to obtaining Gold certification
- If it were recognized, we would be the first convention centre in the world to obtain this award
- The Healthy Venue programme involves a careful selection of foods in terms of reduction of dietary fats, sugars and salt and the invitation for guests to implement healthy practices for a better personal well-being



LEED certification



- We are currently working to get **LEED management certification (O+M)** from the USGBC (the United States Green Building Council)
- In particular we are carrying out many interventions aimed at monitoring and reducing significantly electricity, water and thermal consumption
- Our aim is to reach this goal **by the end of next summer**



IN PROGRESS

Support to Non-Profit Organizations



- Our company (FMC) provides its support to **volunteer projects directly proposed by the employees** and recognizes the possibility for each person to be able to perform **4 hours per year** of work in projects that have this purpose
- Every year one project is chosen, among the ones proposed, for which the company **offers a small financial support (e.g. 5,000 €)**



Food for Good



- At the customer's request, It's possible to activate - through the internal catering supplier - a process that allows **the recovery of food that is not consumed during events** to donate it to local bodies that deal with people in need
- Directly contacting the caterer it is possible to know **how to access to the program** and the how to select the menus that allow the recovery of food according to the Italian laws
- At the end of the event it can be provided a report about the amount of food recovered and the destination of the same by **Banco Alimentare Onlus** (the main Italian Food Bank Organization)



Plastic-free



- The European Commission recently proposed EU-wide rules to **ban the 10 single-use plastic products** most often found on Europe's beaches and seas
- By adopting the directives of the European Commission and the Italian Ministry of the Environment, MiCo is considering - together with its suppliers - to **abolish single-use plastic** from the venue and its offices **by next summer**
- Today the only constraint element is the replacement of the plastic bottles of mineral water currently sold. Finding the best solution we are ready to go
